Accredited by the University of Derby and working alongside University of Greenwich, we develop excellent teachers who are resilient, critical, and reflective classroom practitioners. Trainees benefit from the university's commitment to inclusivity, diversity and serving disadvantaged communities. The well-structured curriculums and placement-based training prepare trainees well to enter the world of teaching. (Ofsted 2023)

This school-based programme with QTS* is designed to prepare beginning teachers to meet the Teachers' Standards. Throughout the programme, beginning teachers will be challenged to achieve these standards to the highest level and we shall aspire to enable them to achieve outstanding levels of professional practice through both the taught curriculum and their placement practice.

Beginning teachers will follow one of two pathways: 3-7 years, covering Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) and Key Stage 1 or 5–11 years, covering Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2. The age phase route they follow will determine the assessed placements undertaken.

The Tuition Fee programme offers:

- full-time school-based training with University of Greenwich
- a minimum of 24 weeks placement in two of The Mosaic Trust's ten schools located in Bromley, Dartford and Kent with remaining time at university



- an intensive training placement for an additional 4 weeks where you will focus on core elements of practice
- a personal tutor
- a choice to specialise in EYFS, KS1 or KS2
- support by mentors and experienced teachers within the schools and across the Trust

Entry requirements for programmes leading to QTS are determined by the ITT Accreditation criteria available through the Department for Education.

A good honours degree (2:2 or above) from a UK university or an equivalent qualification For entry on to any Initial Teacher Education (ITE) programme, there is a minimum requirement nationally of a Grade C (Grade 4) or above in English Language, science, and mathematics at GCSE).

Candidates are also required to demonstrate suitability to teach through an interview which assesses personal and academic qualities, use of Standard English, and health and physical capacity to teach.

DBS and Health check required.

Our Schools

Cage Green Primary School

Cage Green Primary School joined the Connect Academy Trust in 2019 with an Ofsted Grading of Inadequate. Having made rapid improvement, it gained an Ofsted Grading of Good in November 2023.

At Cage Green, the leaders believe that with the right support and opportunities children can achieve anything. The Growth Mindset approach is embedded into the curriculum and this teaches the children that if they work hard they are capable of anything.

The core values of Determination, Excellence, Integrity, Respect and Responsibility are embedded in the day to day lives at Cage Green. They are promoted with the children during lessons, circle times, assemblies, playtimes and in every interaction throughout the day.

Crofton Infant School and Crofton Junior School

<u>Crofton Infant School</u> has been part of the Connect Academy Trust since 2012. It maintained the Ofsted Grading of Outstanding in November 2021.

It is a very large 6 form entry school as well as the 540 children in our mainstream Reception - Year 2 classes, we also have a specialist provision at the Infant school, providing high quality education for 18 children with severe and complex needs. Crofton Cubs Pre-School offers places for ages 2 and over.

<u>Crofton Junior School</u> has been part of the Connect Academy Trust since its inception in 2011. It has an Ofsted Grading of Outstanding in July 2023.

It is a very large, six form entry school, on roll number at the Junior School is 720, but despite our size, Crofton remains a very friendly school with a strong community feel

The curriculum at both **Crofton Schools** is underpinned with the drivers of Global Awareness, Aspirations and stereotypes, Cultural Diversity and Environment. Children learn that about the world around them, the jobs they may aspire to and the importance of taking care of the environment.

The core values of Creative, Resilient, Open Minded, Friendly, Tolerant, Optimistic and Neighbourly are woven through the curriculum and the children demonstrate these values this ensures a smooth transition from the Infants to the Juniors. During their day children learn the importance of giving to others through the charitable schemes in place.
